## 01

#### Trainings on ICT/MIS Applications

SIRD, Meghalaya organised two (2) training programs on *"ICT/MIS Applications for Enhancing Digital Literacy in Rural Meghalaya*" in NIELIT, Tura.

- 1<sup>st</sup> Program held for VEC functionaries Rongram C&RD Block, West Garo Hills District from 26<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> September 2022
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Program held for VEC functionaries, Dalu C&RD Block, West Garo Hills District from 29<sup>th</sup> September - 1<sup>st</sup> October 2022.

It included training on:

- Hardware & Software components of a Computer System.
- MS Office tools.
- Basic application installation & set up.
- Implementation of MGNREGA Applications viz. Geotagging, NMMS, Mission Antyodaya & GPDP Facilitator Report.

The programme was led *by Smti. Elizabeth Thma (Faculty Member - IT, SIRD Meghalaya).* A total of 52 Participants attended the programs.

#### 02 Trainings on Village Poverty Reduction Plan

SIRD, Meghalaya organised two (2) training programs on *"Village Poverty Reduction Plan".* It was held in Mawkyrwat C&RD Block, South West Khasi Hills District.
