Training & Events



Induction Training Programme for VCFs – Batch XI

SIRD, Meghalaya organised an *Induction Training Programme for Village Community Facilitators (VCFs)- Batch XI* for the Megh-LIFE Project being implemented by Meghalaya Basin Development Authority (MBDA). It was conducted for 3 days from $22^{nd} - 24^{th}$ August, 2022 in ETC, Tura. The objectives of the program were to:

- Impart knowledge on the role of VCFs as community mobilizer.
- Identify PRA and its tools.
- Importance of MIS for reporting,
- Importance of participatory monitoring.
- Importance of community nursery & bookkeeping.

It was led by *Shri Francis Ch Sangma* (Faculty Member, SIRD Nongsder) and was attended by 33 participants.





Induction Training Programme for VCFs Batch XII

SIRD, Meghalaya organised an *Induction Training Programme for Village Community Facilitators (VCFs)- Batch XII* for the Megh-LIFE Project being implemented by Meghalaya Basin Development Authority (MBDA). It was conducted for 3 days from 25th - 27th August, 2022 in ETC, Tura. The objectives of the program were to:

- Importance of community nursery & bookkeeping.

The programme was led by Smti. Elizabeth Thma (Faculty Member - IT, SIRD Meghalaya) and was attended by 26 Participants.
